

A Day in Southport

Monday 15th July 2019

Once we arrive in Southport, the day is yours to do with as you wish.

Not only does Southport have 22 miles of coast but also boasts the Grade II listed Southport Pier. The oldest iron pier in the country, standing for over 150 years, the 1,000 metre long Pier is the second longest in the country.

A walk to the end of Southport Pier will give you views across the North West and on a clear day, you can see neighbouring Blackpool and even the North Wales coast.

If that sounds too much like hard work, why not hop on to the pier tram, which will take you straight to the end where you can grab a cup of tea in the pier pavilion. The pier pavilion also has a small exhibition on Southport's history.

There is an excellent long, flat sea front promenade perfect for a leisurely stroll, with plenty of resting spots along the way.

Explore Lord Street and the wrought iron canopies, meander in and out of the shops along the way. Take a look around Wayfarers Shopping Arcade, a Grade II listed building and home to over 30 independent stores.
